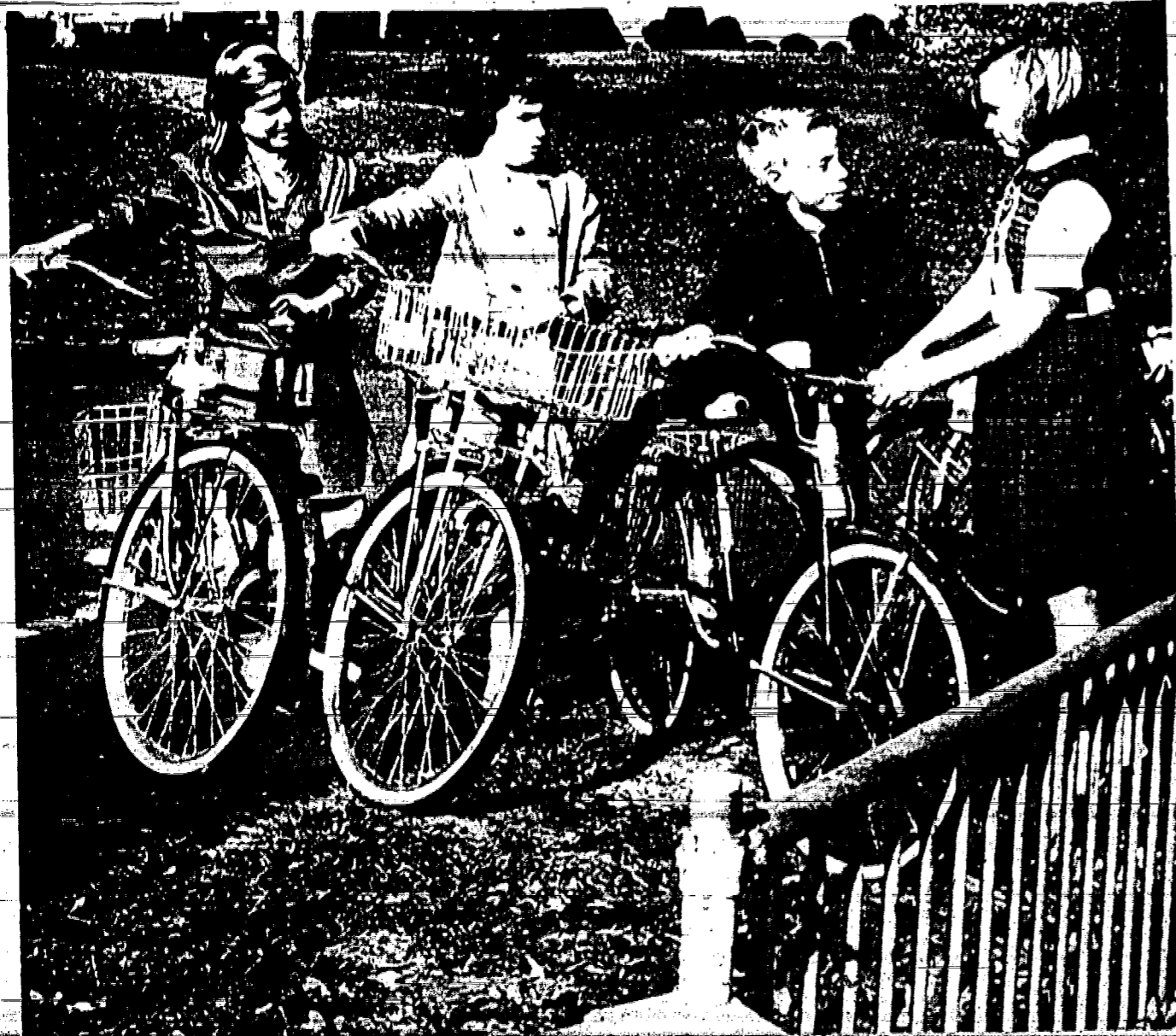

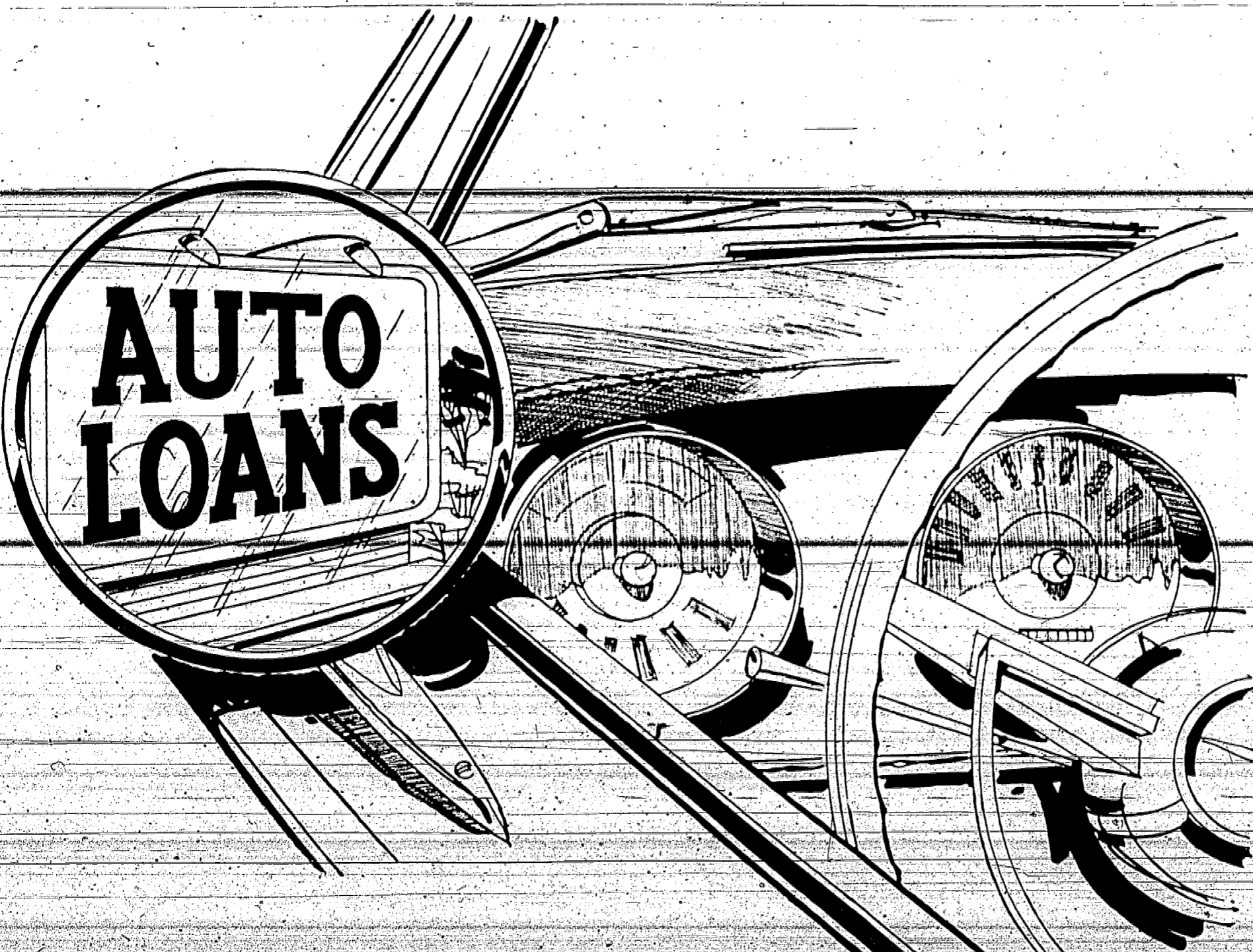
Starting New Duties As Police Chief, Urges Greater Use Of County Parks
