## Schnitzers Find Retreat In Local Hills

### Ornithologists Travel To Study Migration Paths

High in the hills of the mountainside, a small, secluded retreat has been discovered by Albert and Eva Schnitzer, nature lovers both, who have spent the last seven years of their lives in the study of bird migration. The retreat is a small, wooded area that breaks the forest canopy and is the call of a bird of the air, a scuffle of a chipmunk among the leaves of a maple tree.

This is the refuge which Albert and Eva Schnitzer, nature lovers both, had moved into seven years ago so they could live close to nature with woods and sky around them, and within easy traveling distance of Elizabeth, where Alberta firm, Schnitzer Associates, is located. And, as a result, they follow their favorite hobby — ornithology.

The Schnitzers, nationally known as a family of bird lovers, recently from a trip to Greece and Turkey, returned to their home in Elizabeth, N. J., where they were joined by their field assistants, Albert and Eva, to study the migration paths of the birds of that area.

The mystery of bird migration has long been a favorite subject for both of them. "How," Albert asks, "does a bird know where to go? How does a bird know where to go? How does a bird know where to go?"
