

Agreement weds county and China

Chairman of the Union County Board of Chosen Freeholders, Daniel Sullivan and the mayor of Wenzhou, China, signed a Sister City Agreement last week that will enhance the county's economic development opportunities abroad as well as add to education, technological and science achievements in the near future.

Sullivan said that it has been four years since the county established a sister city relationship with Wenzhou. "In 1994 both states agreed to exchange information that would result in exchanges in economic, science, technology, culture, education and other areas," Sullivan said. "I consider it a milestone when a direct link is formed that recognizes

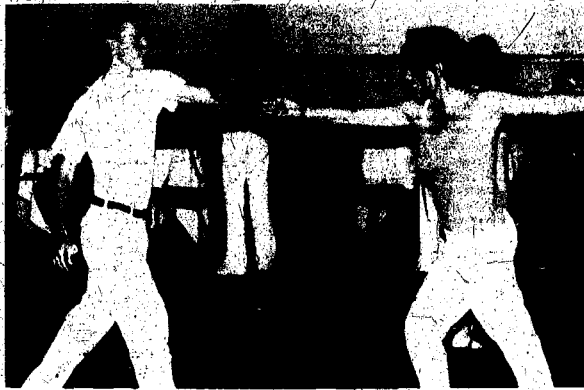
