Edward Beglin Jr., but his legacy and inspiration will live on. Rinaldo was credited with reducing crime and bringing law enforcement closer to people. His initiatives included creating the county's first domestic violence and anti-harassment units and the successful Essex Union Auto Theft Task Force.

"His presence is still felt in Union County," Scaturi said. "The relationships he built up and outside the county will be remembered."

"It's difficult to critique someone who always knew what to say," said his widow, Mary Rinaldo, 58, a county freeholder.

The former prosecutor knew she was going to be a lawyer in eighth grade after reading "To Kill a Mockingbird." He wanted to be like the character in the book, Atticus Finch, a Southern attorney who represented black man wrongfully accused of raping a white woman.

Elizabeth Mayor J. Christian Bellavance related several stories about Rinaldo from their times on the golf course. Rinaldo was once asked why he did not do more at his lag in racing where he could make more money and be able to have more material items for his family. Bellavance said he believed "service to others" was more important than a few extra things.

One discussed as the potential site of a new juvenile detention center, office building which once housed a bank, was purchased by the county for \$2 million and renovated at a cost of \$3 million.

Dennis Leary, the hyper comedian who first gained attention with his fast-paced 30-second rant on MTV, stars in "Monument Avenue," a hard-edged story about low-level drug dealers in modern-day Boston. Leary plays Bobby, a 30-something who lives at home with his mother. He spends his time drinking, getting high and stealing cars for the local kingpin, Jackie, played by the always effective Colm Meaney. Bobby brings his cousin, Seamus, from Ireland to Boston using his steady income from illegal petty crimes. Together with Bobby's pal Mouse, played nicely by Ian Hart, the three make some cash, do more drugs and drift aimlessly toward even more uncertainty.

This monotonous lifestyle seems to grip a stretching halt. Another of Bobby's cousins, Stuart, is released from prison after serving seven years for a drug crime. He was softly reformed, but remained an asset to the gang and was released early for good behavior. As Robbie, Stuart and some buddies are downing some beers at a local pub and laughing about his newfound freedom, a stranger walks through the door, approaches the table and fires two bullets into Stuart's chest. It's not a good moment for Stuart. He dies instantly.

Though the guy is filled with doozey boozers, this crime, like all the murders in Bobby's neighborhood, is bound for the unsolved file. The sole reason for the unfortunate future is the lack of willingness of the witnesses to open their mouths. A detective soon arrives on the scene and Bobby, just like everybody else in the bar, confesses to seeing nothing because he "was in the bathroom" when the shots were fired. All the other patrons use the exact same "in the bathroom" line. The detective, played by screen vetter Martin Sheen, berates Bobby for not defending his relative and vows to take the "culprit" down.

Legislation to limit tier-rating increases for non-at-fault accidents

Long-term automobile insurance regulations you method industry can exploit to raise rates, Assembly Democratic Conference Leader James Anthony Imperato and Assembly Deputy Minority Leader Neil M. Cohen have introduced legislation that would prohibit insurers from raising rates when a driver is involved in a fatal auto accident.

The tier-rating method of assessing auto insurance premiums was enacted by the Republican-controlled legislature in June 1997. It rates each of the 5 percent car auto insurance rate paid last year. The tier-rating system, which took effect in New York last year, replaced the former more strict standard.

The proposed bill, A. 254, would prohibit tier rating for at-fault accidents as of January 1, 2000.

Why should people be penalized for accidents that were not their fault? asked Imperato. "I, Mr. Hansen," the bill would address, "a driver who is driving in the deteriorating economy."

Under tier-rating, drivers are grouped into tiers. Drivers who qualify for lower risk tiers will pay the lowest rates. Those who fall in high-risk categories will pay higher rates. Some companies offer as many as 13 tiers and corresponding rates, while others have as many as five. Industry officials estimated that about 40 percent of the state's drivers would see their rates increase under this system.

A tier-rating policyholders with good driving records is ludicrous, said A. 254. "It forces consumers into a tiered system. It forces drivers to pay for driving with one hand and taking away with the other."
