## Recycled earth could be the answer

### Dredged sediment may restore beaches

Can we recycle the earth itself the way we recycle paper and bottles? In some cases the answer may be yes, says Dr. Robert Pauly, director of Rutgers University's Marine Sciences Center. The center, in cooperation with the Cooperative Education Service of Rutgers-Camden College, is about to try whether sediment dredged from the New Jersey Inland Waterway in Ocean County can be used to replenish beaches and dunes along the coast.

## EARTHBOUND

Many citizens are unaware of the extremely damaging effect which generation of electrical power has had and continues to have on the health of our nation's water resources. This is true because that of many other industries which use and discharge into their surrounding streams and rivers, however, the power industry has a well-developed reputation for research and development in protecting and restoring the health of the water resources which are its most important natural assets—areas which are the nursery grounds for the young population of important food and gamefish. Eggs and larval stages of striped bass, shad, alewife, menhaden, weakfish and bluefish are washed into the lakes of power plants by the hundreds of thousands and then lost forever in the light and turbid waters of condensers and other equipment.

It is a clear and well-documented fact that prior to the mid-1950's the biological considerations were taken into account by engineers who design and execute designs for major industrial power plants along water fronts. As a result, most of these facilities have the most primitive, least expensive methods of technology in the environmental protection area.
