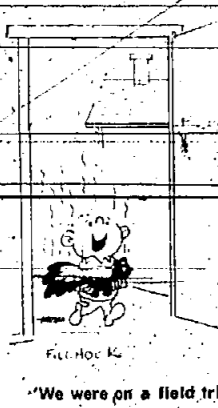

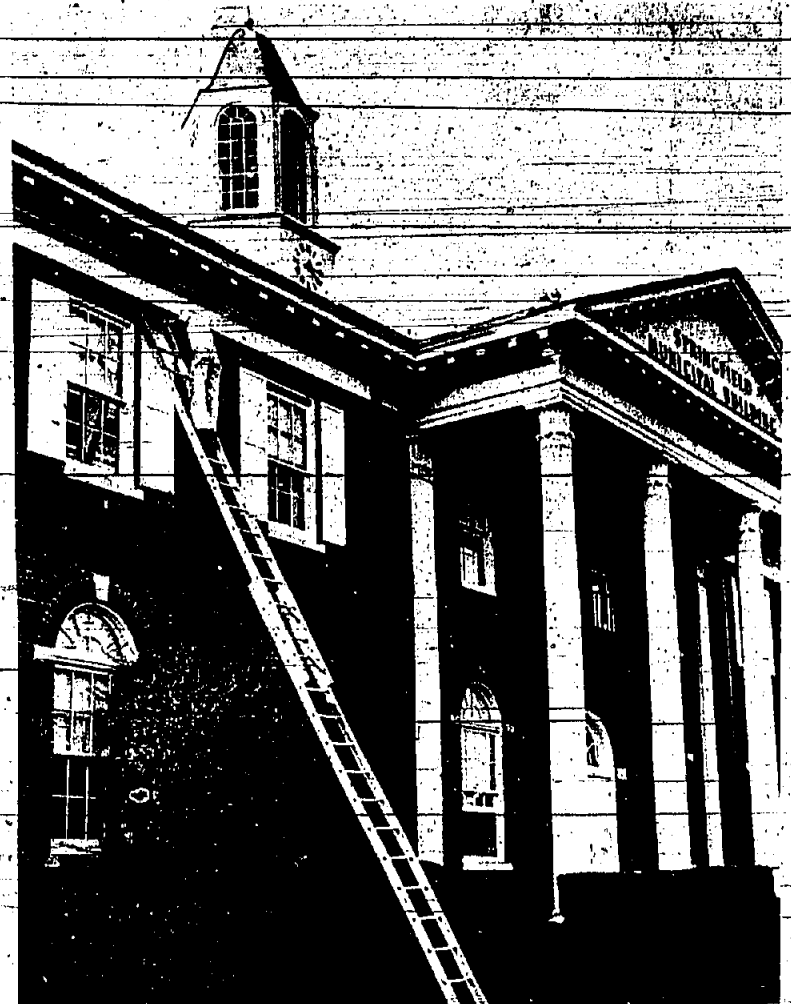

4 men arrested at supermarket on drug charges

Springfield police reported the arrest last week of four men accused of possession of a stolen prescription blank and of conspiring to obtain narcotics by fraud. The apprehension came one day after local detectives had held a conference with the supermarket's security chief on the problem of forged blanks being passed at the store's drug department.

According to police, a store employee notified them shortly after 5:30 p.m. Nov. 17 that an apparently forged blank had been presented at the pharmacy. P.I. Robert Maguire went to the market and arrested Timothy Drake, 25, of Newark; James Perry, 25, of Hillside; Edward R. Scott, 23, and his brother, Bruce Scott, 20, both of East Orange.

Local detectives reported that because forged blanks had been presented at the store during the past two months, they had met the previous day with Shop-Rite security officers to brief him on the problem. "We told him what to look for and asked him to inform the other employees. The way they were instructed, watching for these blanks," a police department spokesman noted.

Drake and the Scott brothers were released on \$500 bail each. Perry was remanded to Union County Jail, Elizabeth, in lieu of \$700 bail. All were to be arraigned in Springfield Municipal Court Monday night.

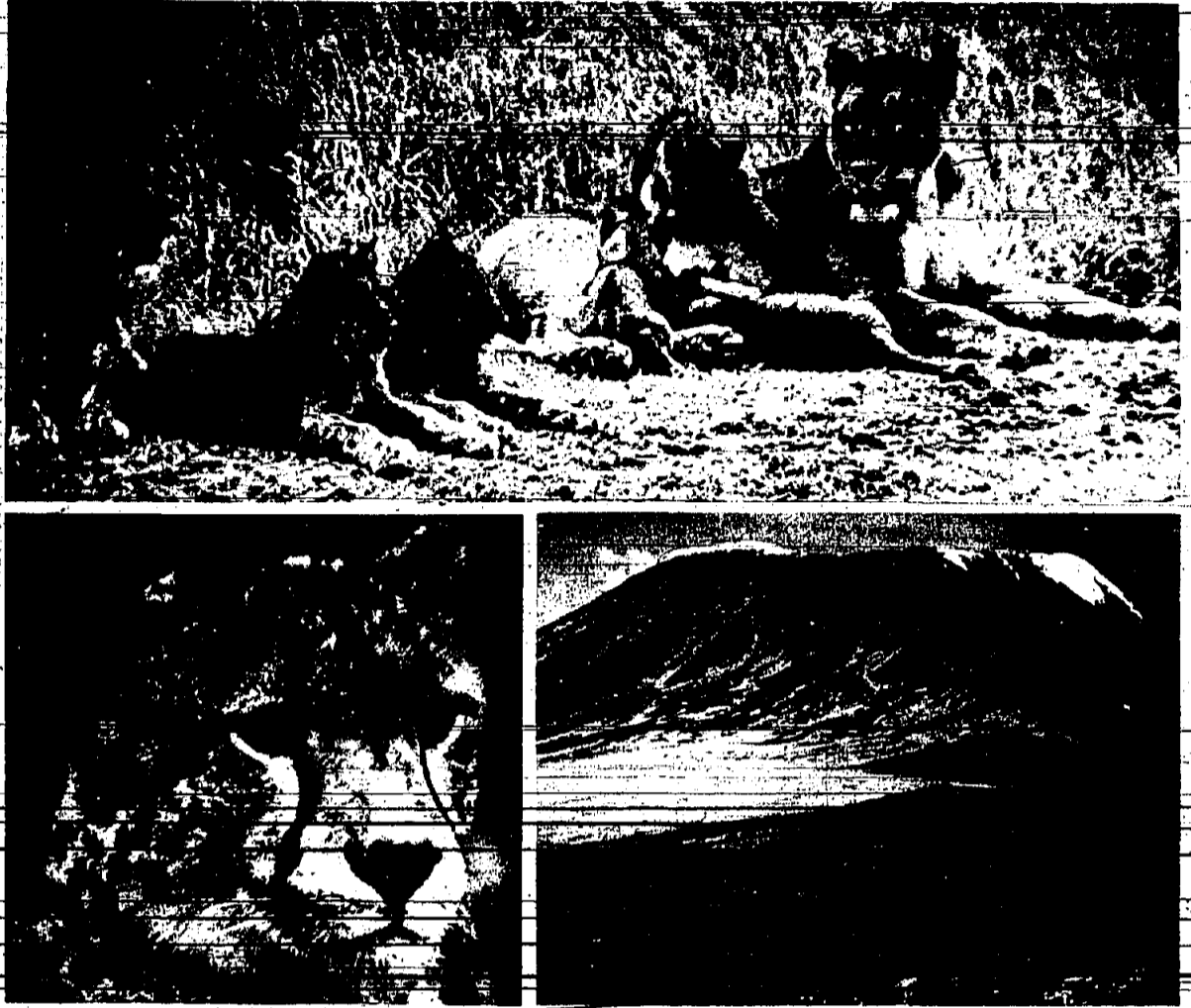
