NJ Transit approves changes in routes

Changes in the schedule proposed by NJ Transit's approximately 300 of the 8,000 daily riders on the lines will be adversely affected, and 260 of those will have to be transported by other means available to them. Only 10 riders will be without service.

Denver is no 'foreigner' to the stage

Gilligan may have left his private island but Bob Denver has found it again!

In fact, Denver, who played the title role in the television series, "Gilligan's Island" for three years, loved Hawaii so much that about eight years ago, he and his wife, Dreama, bought a home on the island of Kauai in Hawaii.

"When I'm there, I'm home," smiled Denver during a visit backstage in his dressing room at the Paper Mill Playhouse, Millburn, where the actor is portraying Charlie Baker in "The Foreigner" comedy. "After my last performance on March 23 here at the Paper Mill," says the youthful looking Denver, "we're going home."

"You can't imagine," he said, lighting a cigarette, "what a beautiful place that is. Why, it's a joy just to go to the store. Every foot of it is just gorgeous. You can stand in any corner, do so many things. And we just don't do anything...except maybe once in a while go snorkelfishing."

Denver sighed dreamily as he reminisced. "We shot the first 'Gilligan' series there...on a beautiful little bay that was right out of a travel brochure. Usually," he said, "it rains a lot there. But for 40 days during January and February, the sun came out. Can you just picture yourself, hopping out of bed in the morning, walking two feet and jumping into the calm ocean? And a half hour later, you're having a big breakfast in your hotel."

He grinned. "Of course, it can rain for 40 days, too."

Denver was born in New Rochelle, N. Y.

where he attended local schools, moved to Brownwood, Tex., with his family, where they owned and operated a candy manufacturing business. Then they moved to California, where Bob completed his secondary education. After high school, he enrolled at Loyola University as a pre-law major. He also discovered the Del-Ray Players and served as house manager.

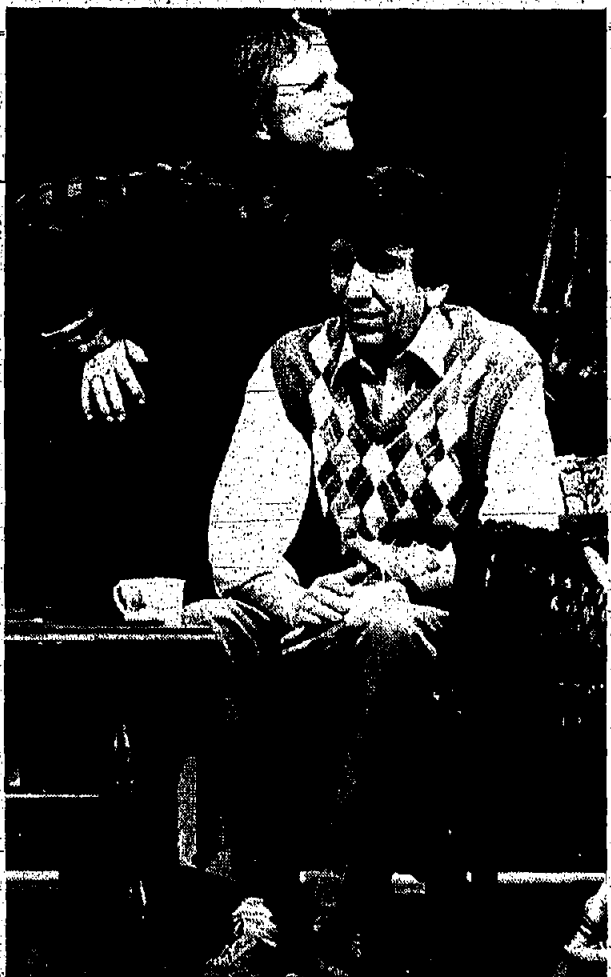
"My brother finished law school when I graduated from college. He was a year ahead of me. I had all the briefs and brochures and spent three months trying to make up my mind. I decided I would rather work in the theater. I had no desire to be a star. I just wanted to act."

"Still, when I was asked to read for this part of Seaman Urban, a nervous sailor providing comedy relief in 'The Caine Mutiny Court Martial,' I was in a quandary. It was worse when they liked me. 'I won't do it,' I said. 'You got it,' they said. 'I don't want to get out there,' I shouted. So, when they pushed me out there, people laughed a lot. I was hooked."

Denver said that "each time you're on stage, it's more fun and it gets easier. My advice is get in a play immediately...as many as you can in a year. Rehearsals don't mean a thing. Just get out there and do it."

While waiting for a chance to act, Denver took a job as athletic director at Corpus Christi Grammar School in Pacific Palisades, Calif. "I taught fourth-grade arithmetic and seventh-grade history and coached eighth-graders in football, basketball and baseball." Denver also
