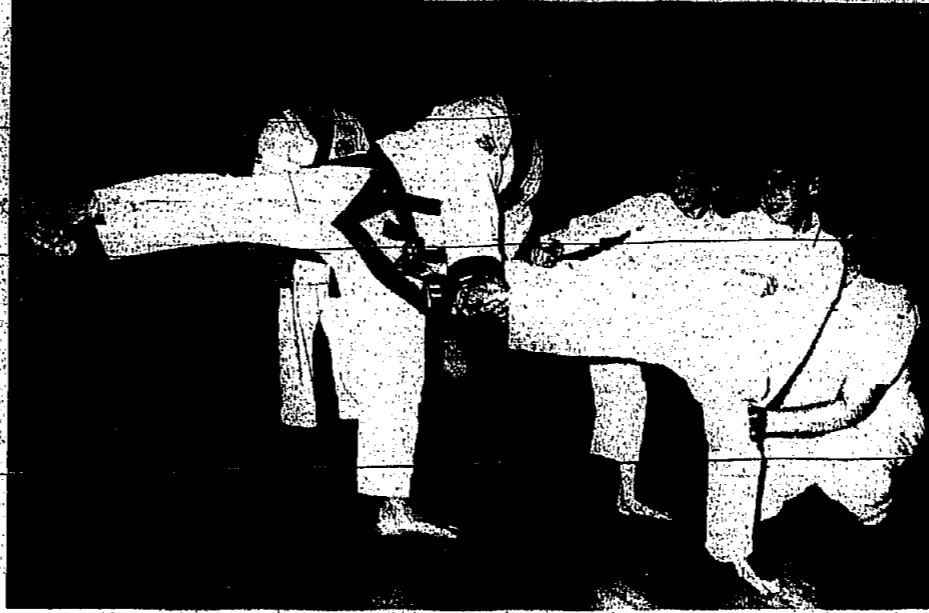

Hippotherapy, which means "treatment with the help of a horse," uses the movement of a horse to improve the physical skills of children with mobility problems. The Hippotherapy Program at Saint Barnabas utilizes a team approach to help participants improve balance, posture, range of motion, proprioception and self-esteem. The team consists of an occupational therapist and a physical therapist, who are registered hippotherapists and a horse.

Words of encouragement resonate throughout the mirrored room at the Iwanga Karate Studio in Springfield. The room is the riding arena, where the child spends the next 15 minutes on horseback. "The ride benefits each child differently because the horse's movements mimic those of its rider," said Wiseman. "If a child has certain mobility problems, riding the horse will activate muscles which would not normally be used."

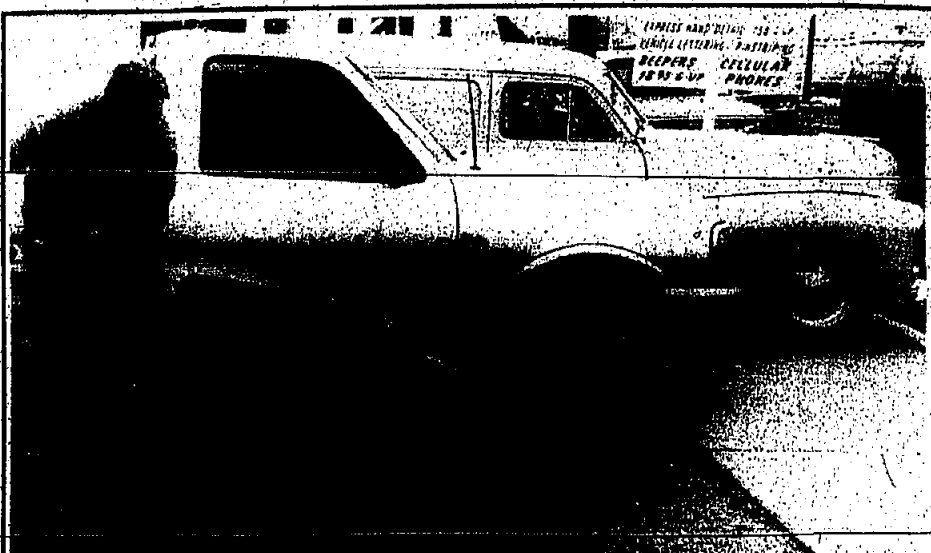

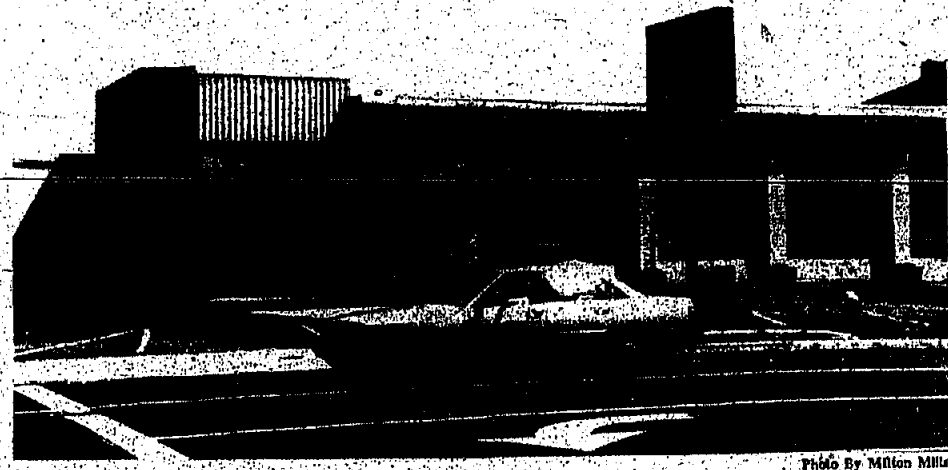
