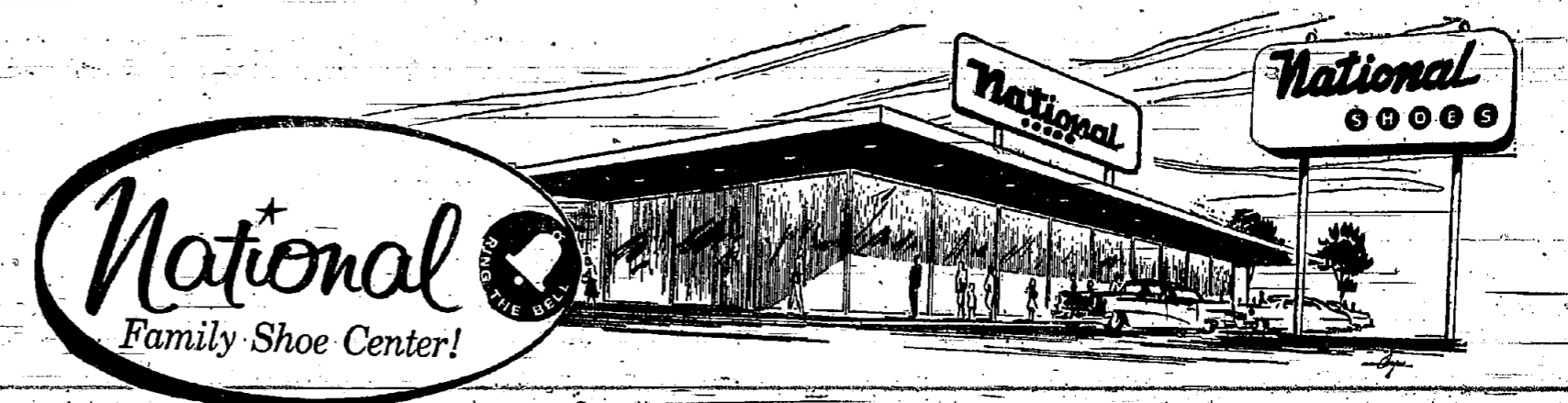

the fertilizer spreader and thus applied about four times as much fertilizer to these areas. The excess fertilizer caused the severe burning. Next time make certain that you shut off the spreader completely before making a turn.

Q: My lawn is filled with patches of little, white flower tufts about an inch high. Shall I use a weed killer?

A: This grass is known as annual bluegrass, or poa annua. It is the scourge of golf courses and parks and difficult to eradicate without damaging the desirable turf grasses. Better leave it alone, because the flowers will soon disappear and you will be unable to tell if from the Kentucky bluegrass in the lawn. Unfortunately, poa annua is an annual when it dies it will leave a brown area for a while, but quickly reseeds itself and fills the area with new grass.

Q: Last week you mentioned that tent caterpillars come in cycles of nine or ten years. What causes this cycle?
